Applying for Financial Assistance

Beginning October 1, students can complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2025-26 academic year, online at www.StudentAid.gov. Our federal school code is 002575 and must be included on the application for FPU to receive a copy of the application and results. Once we receive your FAFSA, the OSFS will evaluate your application, and complete your financial aid award in accordance with our policies and best practices.

Financial Clearance

The OSFS reviews all student accounts for financial clearance prior to the start of every term/semester. To be considered financially clear, students must have a zero balance on their account, through either anticipated financial assistance, an active payment plan in good standing (Rindge Campus Study Only), or payment made in full. Students who are not financially clear may be blocked from course registration or registrations may be dropped by the end of the add/drop period. Students who are not financially clear will receive notification from the OSFS as to their remaining account balance, options to reach financial clearance, and expected timelines.
